Bar Manager	The Bar Manager is responsible for managing the bar, beverage programs, culinary operations, Refuel, and the execution of banquet events.
Housekeeping Supervisor	Maintain cleanliness standards of the Hotel in all areas of the Hotel. Effectively manage Housekeeping staff to accomplish daily tasks of the Housekeeping operation. Act as liaison between the operating departments of the Hotel, Front office, Engineering and Housekeeping. Understand operating goals of the hotel. Fulfill the Hotel Service Culture in daily activities
Room Attendant	Maintain cleanliness standards of the hotel in all guest rooms and public areas.
House Attendant	Maintain cleanliness standards of the Hotel in all public and back of house areas.
Maintenance Engineers	The maintenance engineer is responsible for hotel guestroom preventive maintenance and assists in the repairs and maintenance of hotel equipment.
Guest Service Agents	Check in and check out hotel guests courteously and efficiently; process all payments according to established hotel requirements. Provide information to any guest or visitor inquiry. Process Refuel purchases and orders.
Front Office Supervisor	Responsible for the supervision of all aspects of the Front Desk functions, in accordance with hotel standards.
Night Auditor	Verify the accuracy of figures, calculations, and postings pertaining to daily business transactions recorded by other staff members by performing various analyses of accounting records. Compile, review and distribute various reports to appropriate members. Conduct all front desk services for guests and associates.
Security	To patrol hotel premises to maintain order, enforce regulations, and ensure observance of applicable laws by performing the duties as assigned and according to hotel standards.
Cook	The cook is responsible for food preparation and assigned kitchen duties. Work hours/days vary as dictated by business needs, and includes weekends and holidays.
F&B Attendant/ Steward	The F&B attendant is responsible for general cleanliness of hotel property. Attendant will maintain Refuel grab and go in accordance with brand guidelines. Attendant will set up, serve and breakdown meeting events. Position requires deep cleaning of physical surroundings. Work hours/days vary as dictated by business needs, and include all weekends and holidays.
Bartenders	The Bartender is responsible for providing food and beverage service to all our guests.
